

WHITE GOLD LIMEWASH

PRODUCTS

- White all-purpose primer
- Golden Paintworks Acrylic Limewash
- Golden Paintworks Metallic White Veil
- Golden Paintworks White Gold

TOOLS

- Nappie winnie roller
- 4" box brush



HOW TO:

- 1 | Base paint with a white, high-hiding, all purpose primer.
- 2 | Using a nappy winnie roller, apply two coats of Golden Paintwork, Metallic White Veil, dry in between coats. Apply full coverage, rolling in a random pattern; for this application overlapping paint lines is not a concern. *(Photos 1-2)*
- 3 | Mix 1 part Metallic White Gold with 4 parts Acrylic Limewash. Using the box brush, apply random strokes in a crisscross pattern, achieving full coverage. Apply two coats, drying in between coats. *(Photos 3-4)*
- 4 | Complete one wall at a time without any “stops and starts,” to provide a more uniform look.
Here is the final finish. *(Photo 5)*
